

Spanish and ECTS grading systems

The Spanish University grading system is based on decimal grades with a precision of two decimal digits. In order to facilitate the transcripts an equivalence table can be found below.

ECTS SCALE	DEFINITION	% OF PASSING STUDENTS
A Excellent	outstanding performance with only minor errors	top 10% (90%–100%)
B Very good	above the average standard but with some errors	next 25% (65%–90%)
C Good	generally good work with a number of notable errors	next 30% (35%–65%)
D Satisfactory	fair but with significant shortcomings	next 25% (10%–35%)
E Sufficient	passable performance, meeting the minimum criteria	next 10% (0%–10%)
FX Fail	some more work required before the credit can be awarded	
F Fail	considerable further work is required	

Remarks:

- '-' or 'NP' means Dash ("-") means, "Student did not take the exam". In Spain, it has no negative sense.
- Blank spaces in mark columns means, "Marks not yet set".
